INVESTMENT POLICY OF THE FUND:

The fund aims to share in the yields of the Turkish equity market, and to profit from Turkey's economic growth through share price gains and dividend income. Given the risk profiles of the equity investments, the fund is classified as a high-risk investment. The fund manager's intentions are that the fund's portfolio should consist predominantly of the publicly traded shares of foreign-domiciled companies. The primary investment targets are the stock exchange-traded shares of companies that maintain an active presence in Turkey, or that generate a substantial proportion of their revenues in the Turkish market. When building the fund's portfolio, beyond the minimum statutory requirements, the principles of safety and maximum diversification (the spreading of risk) are observed. The fund management company, exercising all due care, determines the means of utilising the fund's resources on the basis of its own judgement and decisions, while observing the relevant legal provisions and the limitations stipulated in the Fund Documentation and by taking into account the macroeconomic environment of the investment markets, relying primarily on fundamental analysis. When compiling the portfolio, it is shares that determine the nature of the fund, and thus the proportion of shares that may be held in the fund at any given moment may reach the prevailing statutory maximum. When determining the weights, within the equity investments, of shares traded in the Turkish market, we aim to ensure that the fund - in line with our expectations with regard to future risks and yields - achieves its objective, which is to outperform the benchmark advertised by the fund, over the longer term. The fund records its assets in forint; the fund management company may, at its own discretion, choose to hedge all or a part of its currency risks with forward currency positions, in compliance with the applicable statutory requirements. Under the current legislation the proportion of shares in the portfolio may be up to 100%

MARKET SUMMARY:

Equity markets fluctuated throughout April closing the month practically flat. The rally started in February lost some steam in mid-April on mixed macro newsflow and profit taking. The US earnings season delivered mixed results with revenues trailing behind the consensus, while bottom line data once again surpassed analyst expectations. The USD was under pressure as the FED once again postponed its rate hike. Commodities, on the other hand, were supported by the weakening USD, particularly precious metals surging to multi-year highs. Regardless of the unsuccessful Doha meeting on production freeze, oil prices kept rallying for the most part of the month. The Turkish equity market managed to gain again in April. The reduction in bond yields was favorable for the banking sector stocks. Inflows and short covering support the raise in the equity market.


